PLLC UPB Appliance Relays are a 240 Volt 50 Hz 10 AMP device. Suitable for controlling 3rd part devices up to a maximum of 10AMP e.g. Electric Blanket...Fan...etc ...see list below of 3rd part device wattages to be used as a guide only. Care should be taken to confirm your device Wattage usage.

NB: ENSURE THAT YOUR UPB APPLIANCE RELAY IS SET TO "SNAP ON AND SNAP OFF"...THIS IS CRITICAL!.

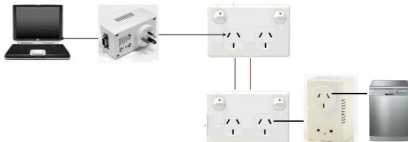

1. Press the UP Button 5 times.... LED begins to flash GREEN ...
2. Press the DOWN button 10 times... LED now starts to Flash RED
3. Then Press the UP button 2 times...LED stops flashing....the Unit has now be defaulted
4. Now place to unit in Setup Mode ...Press UP button 5 times, to put device into Setup Mode....LED starts flashing GREEN
5. By using the UPSTART Software, downloaded from the PLLC Web site, you can now discover your UPB device and place or create your NEW Network

The software used to configure and program the UPB system is called "UPSTART".
